# **NEW GRAD REQUIREMENT**

Public Act 101-180 (effective 6/01/20) requires that, beginning with the 2020-2021 school year, public high school students must complete the FAFSA or, as eligible, the Alternative Application for Illinois Financial Aid, as a prerequisite to receiving a high school diploma. A waiver provision basically allows a parent, guardian, or the student - if 18 or emancipated - to opt out for any reason.

Premier has two representatives from ISAC (Illinois Student Assistance Commission) that can assist you with filling out the Financial Aid Applications linked below. This is a free service, and I highly recommend utilizing their expertise! They are currently offering presentations and individual virtual appointments to accommodate any of your needs.
